
When France collapses in June 1940, Jacques Leboy finds himself deported to the east, like so many others, without any certainty as to what the future holds. After arriving at the Stablack Camp, he is assigned to the rather unusual Stalaq 1A. This "aspilaq" camp, the result of an agreement between Nazi authorities and the Vichy government, was specifically designed for aspiring officers of the defeated French army. This camp-academy had one purpose: to train a French elite for the "new Europe" after the German victory. Over the course of his time in captivity and his escape attempts, Jacques will by turns question his political and moral choices, as well as his faith in religion and in humanity. Until the day, nearly 40 years later, when he shares this little-known part of history with his youngest son.

Thomas Legrand's father's true story is a social and political one; that of an elite that failed, then divided—some choosing inaction, others betrayal, and a few seeking to preserve their honor.




Thomas Legrand is a political journalist and columnist. He has worked in particular for Libération, RTL, and France Inter, where he hosted and produced the show "En quête de politique." Alongside François Warzala, he published a comic entitled L'Histoire de la V^e République in 2018 with Les Arènes. This duo came back together in 2024 to work on Les Évasions perdues, published by Rue de Sèvres.

Comic artitst François Warzala worked with Thomas Legrand on *L'Histoire de la V^e République* (published by Les Arènes) and then did the artwork for *La Trilogie berlinoise* (Les Arènes), alongside Pierre Boisserie.
